TOW 2024 -

Unique in Europe, the TOW (Toulouse Onco Week) is back for its fourth edition, from January 31st to February 4th, 2024., 2024.

This event is organised as part of World Cancer Day. What makes **TOW** special is that it brings together scientists, medical, healthcare and industrial specialists, as well as charities to improve the fight against cancer. In February 2020, more than 2000 people attended the event, which displayed a major mobilisation of the Medical and Scientific Community and made some hopeful announcements.

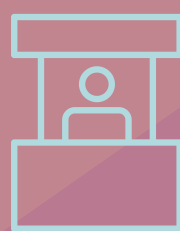

What is new in 2024 ?

New location, in a prestigious historical site.

The Hôtel-Dieu Saint-Jacques, at the heart of Toulouse's life, is a protected site classified as a national heritage site. The building was inscribed and then classified as a Historical Monument in 1986 and 1988 ; it has also been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site for the "chemins de Compostelle" in France since 1998.

The Hôtel-Dieu Saint Jacques will host the different parts of the TOW 2024 with the scientific symposium in "salle des Pèlerins" , the exhibition of partners, posters, the breaks and the gala dinner in "salle des Colonnes" and meeting rooms overlooking the Garonne and the "pont St Pierre".

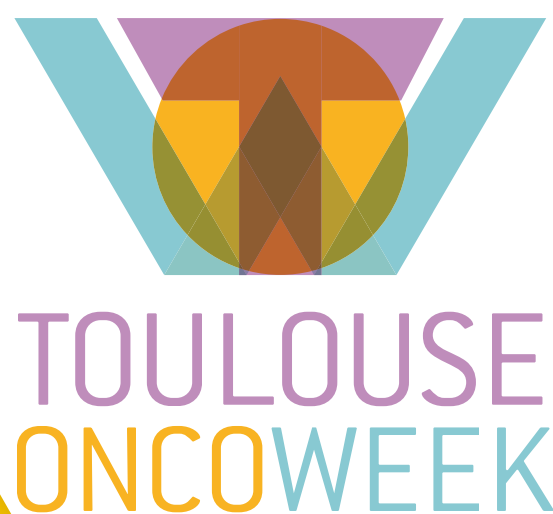
